 Louis Roederer Champagne, famous for Cristal Champagne, is a Champagne house of exceptional quality, aristocratic elegance and distinct style. When he inherited the Champagne House in 1833, the aesthete and entrepreneur Louis Roederer took a visionary approach to enriching his vines, aiming to master every stage of the wine's creation. He forged the wine's unique style, character, and taste. Intense and refined it has notes of apricot hazelnut and Danish pastries. It is a Champagne for the ultimate celebration.
9. **Gouguenheim Malbec 'Bubbles', Mendoza, Argentina** 41.00  
 Sparkling Rose Extra Brut Malbec  
 Patricio Gouguenheim was born in Argentina to French parents. During 2002 in the midst of an economic slump in Argentina, Patricio decided the time was right to leave his job as a banker in the city of Mendoza and start up a winery. He found an old winery in the Uco Valley around 70 km from Mendoza in the heart of the wine producing region. This characterful sparkler is coming from his cellars, full of delicate red fruit aromas and flavours of strawberries, bright cherries with a lovely fresh juiciness on the palate, beautiful balance with tiny bubbles.
10. **Biddenden, Gribble Bridge 2014, Kent, England** 62.00  
 Reichensteiner, Scheurebe and Pinot Noir. Traditional Method.  
 Biddenden Vineyards is Kent's oldest commercial vineyard, established in 1969. The vineyard is set on gentle south-facing slopes, and grows 10 varieties of grapes over 22 acres. All grapes are hand-picked and wines are estate grown and bottled resulting a young, light, fruity and refreshing sparkling wine. A great British sparkler to match a great British lobster.
11. **Cava, Lacrima Baccus, Brut, Reserva, Spain** 36.00  
 Vintage 2020, Organic, Macabeo, Parellada, Traditional Method.  
 Coming from an estate near to Sant Sadurni d' Anoià.  
 Aromatic up front nose with some complexity due to bottle ageing, very fruity with lively apple flavours, with a hint of sweetness.  
 Despite being very unfashionable, a great sparkling wine which truly represents value for money.
12. **Asti Spumante, Piedmont, Italy DOCG** 39.00  
 Muscat Blanc a Petite Grains, Asti Method  
 Asti is the town, south of Turin, that supplies the Muscat grape for the wine. Spuma is Italian for foam. Uniquely, it can be produced on demand. It is a refreshing, slightly sweet sparkling wine which goes well with lemony desserts. Light, delicate and floral.
13. **Prosecco, Cavicchioli, DOC, Italy** 39.00  
 Spumante, Glera, Charmant Method
